

Free Free Foundation Auction London, 2024

Free Free is an ecosystem of change that envisions a world where the feminine is fully awakened among humanity, so women and girls can live in true freedom-spiritually, physically, emotionally, and financially. This vision challenges the deep-rooted cultural and structural constraints that have long been normalized, aiming to transform them through a proprietary methodology blending neuroscience, art, meditation, and the Women, Peace, and Security framework.

By empowering leaders through its social enterprise and membership program and supporting those in extreme vulnerability through its foundation, Free Free seeks to catalyze a global shift towards a more conscious and liberated society, where people remember who they truly are and freedom is attainable for all.

ABOUT THE FREE FREE FOUNDATION

The Free Free Foundation began its journey in Brazil, driven by the belief that everyone should be free. What does this mean? It means breaking free from trauma created by societal and cultural constraints. Why were so many, especially women and girls, struggling emotionally, mentally, financially, and physically? Why was there so much shame, fear, and guilt? Hurt people, hurt people. In a culture focused on appearance, status, and property, no one feels comfortable showing their pain or imperfections, so we hide it deep within, numbing ourselves. But our bodies are intelligent; the pain finds a way out, making us reactive and afraid of being exposed. This fear drives us to control, manipulate, and even engage in violence.

Today, violence is so normalized that many don't even recognize it. We are unconscious.

In August 2018, we introduced the Free Free Methodology, blending neuroscience, psychodrama, meditation, art, and the Women, Peace, and Security framework. This approach helps people confront what's hurting them, breaking free from abusive patterns and finding purpose. Our first workshop, in partnership with the Department of Justice, gathered 40 judges, prosecutors, and commanders. The next day, we supported 30 women who had endured unimaginable abuse, including femicide attempts. A year later, these women had left violent families, secured jobs, and rebuilt their lives, becoming role models for their families.

The mental health crisis today is undeniable: 53% of women facing mental health issues have experienced abuse, and

children in violent homes are 15 times more likely to be assaulted. One in four young women self-harms, and 1 in 7 (aged 16-24) suffers from PTSD, compared to only 3.6% of young men. Suicide rates are rising alarmingly; in many countries, suicide is now the second leading cause of death among youth, with young women experiencing rates three times higher than their male counterparts. Every 62 minutes at least one person dies as a direct result from an eating disorder. Approximately 600 million women live in countries where domestic violence is not yet considered a crime

This crisis places a severe burden on health and legal systems. Yet these systems often fail to address the root causes, like trauma and a lack of safe environments for healing. The traditional health approach treats symptoms without addressing underlying pain, costing economies billions in healthcare, legal expenses, and lost productivity. Violence, mental illness, and suicide cost societies an estimated \$2.5 trillion globally, draining resources and preventing people from reaching their potential.

What happens at home directly affects international affairs - wars, climate change, hunger. Countries where violence is normalised at home and culture has almost two times more chances of having a lower GDP per capita.

Free Free aims to change this by providing consciousness, belonging, love, and purpose. When we understand that our lives matter and that we are unconditionally loved within a community, we gain the courage to heal. We can transform our lives from fear and suffering to love and freedom.

Our mission is clear: we need a top-down and bottom-up approach, enabling leaders and vulnerable communities to uncover and address their inner pain. Violence is not our norm; it is a reaction of a traumatized world locked in survival mode. Through love, compassion, and perspective, we aim to liberate society from the grip of fear, shame, guilt, and abusive patterns.

Over the years, we have reached over 50,000 people directly, empowering them with tools for self-love, confidence, independence, and healing. We've launched community solutions, including Free My Period to combat period poverty and Free Free School Clubs to foster resilience and self-esteem among youth. Partnerships with universities like Harvard and Marangoni help train young leaders to bring solutions to communities.

Talita, a survivor of femicide-related violence, shared: "Free Free gave me a reason to live again, helping me recover my self-esteem. Fashion became my freedom, transforming my life. Now, I believe the world must accept me as I am." Talita's story is one of resilience, embodying the hope we inspire.

Our latest initiative, Free Free Rivers, brings all our solutions into one specific location, focusing on five key areas: Legal/Security, Environment, Economy, Health, and Education. By training leaders in each field, we foster peace and resilience, addressing trauma and lack of opportunity as the root causes of violence. Our goal is to transform communities from fear-driven to love-led, starting with each of us, from within.

Dr. Scarance from Brazil's Department of Justice describes the impact: "The legal system is evolving, but it is still very formal. Our partnership with Free Free has opened new horizons essential to innovating while transforming victims' lives." This shift is deeply personal, affecting both survivors and those in authority.

Our first Free Free Rivers has been launched in Paraíba do Sul, Brazil, a town of 40,000 people. We're training leaders, establishing the Free Free School Club, the Fashion Library, and the Free My Period Project. By 2025, we aim to see reductions in suicide attempts, mental illness, violence, hunger, climate impact, and school dropout rates in this community. Next, we expand to Uganda, The Gambia, and beyond.

Dr. Joan Johnson-Freese of Harvard calls our work "remarkable," saying, "Yasmine and Free Free are a force of nature." Such support from global leaders reflects the impact we're making.

To date, we've indirectly impacted over 70 million people, creating an estimated \$70 million in social value. By 2033, we aim to transform the lives of 100 million, fostering a global movement toward peace, respect, and empowerment.

Today, our foundation takes a vital step toward independence. To create the first three Free Free Rivers intelligent cities, we need to raise £1 million to establish or renovate a Free Free Center in each location—transformational hubs for:

Training local trainers

Implementing community solutions

Funding locally-created projects

With this funding, we'll train leaders, run impactful programs, and measure results to refine and scale our model. Together, we can build resilient, empowered communities, transforming society from within.




